The Danish parliament consist of 179 members and the Government is led by the Social Democrats with Mrs. Mette Frederiksen as the Prime Minister.

Lægevagt – Doctor outside office hours (from 04.00 PM)
Apotek – Pharmacy
Tandlægevagt – Dentist outside office hours (from 04.00 PM)

You can use your phone without any further charges.

- **use of internet (*this is important for Turkey, as in all the other territories the "No Roaming Policy" applies, and we are used to use internet connection of our mobile phone also as "tethering")**
- Most public places and hotels have free Wi-Fi. Note that there is always a safety concern when using public Wi-Fi.
